The Contractor's Representative acknowledges and agrees that, in addition to any and all other applicable rules, regulations, laws or ordinances applicable to the Project or required by the Contract Documents, the provisions, rules and requirements of 29 CFR 1910.136, 29 CFR 1910.137, 29 CFR 1910.269, 29 CFR 1926.97 and 29 CFR 1926 Subpart V (collectively the "2014 OSHA Standards") apply to both the Owner and the Contractor on the Project.

- The Contractor's Representative agrees and warrants that he or she shall comply fully with all of the 2014 OSHA Standards at all times through final completion of the Project and also including any work on the Project site after final completion.
- The Contractor's Representative acknowledges receipt of the Owner's disclosure of the following at or before the pre-construction conference for the Project: (1) the system characteristics for the Project; (2) applicable information known to the Owner (if any) concerning the condition of protective grounds and equipment grounding conductors, the condition of poles, and conditions relating to the safety of the system; (3) system design and operation information relevant to the Project and needed for the Contractor's assessments; and, (4) other system information related to safety on the Project, known to the Owner, and requested by the Contractor.
- The Contractor's Representative acknowledges that the information provided by the Owner in the Hazard Information Sheet and at the pre-Job Safety Meeting is sufficient so as to allow the Contractor to plan the Project and perform the assessments required by the 2014 OSHA Standards.
- The Contractor's Representative acknowledges that all information regarding hazardous conditions that may arise as a result of the Contractor's work on the Project has been provided to the Owner.
- The Contractor's Representative agrees to provide information regarding additional hazardous conditions that may arise during the Project throughout the Work and continuing through final completion of the Project as conditions warrant.
- The Contractor's Representative agrees that the information regarding potential hazards and all other safety related information will be provided by the Contractor to any and all subcontractors and all personnel physically present and working under the Contractor's supervision on the Project, and that proof that the information has been transmitted to such entities and people on the Project will be provided by the Contractor to the Owner at the request of the Owner.

- The Contractor's Representative agrees that it must notify the Owner of any unanticipated hazardous condition at the Project Site within two (2) days after the discovery of the condition.
- The Owner and the Contractor's Representative acknowledge that the Owner and the Contractor have conducted necessary meetings to coordinate their respective work rules before any Work commences on the Project.
